

PILOTING KIWANIS CLUBS DURING UNEXPECTED TIMES

Captain Chesley "Sully" Sullenberger became internationally renowned on January 15, 2009, when he and his crew safely guided US Airways Flight 1549 to an emergency water landing in New York City's frigid Hudson River. The plane's two engines had lost thrust following a bird strike. Everyone survived with only a few minor injuries.

Sullenberger and his crew received international acclaim for their "Miracle on the Hudson," including the passage of a Congressional resolution recognizing their bravery. Sullenberger was ranked second in Time magazine's "Top 100 Most Influential Heroes and Icons of 2009" and was awarded the French Legion of Honor. Sullenberger is the #1 New York Times bestselling author of "Highest Duty: My Search for What Really Matters" and also wrote "Making a Difference: Stories of Vision and Courage from America's Leaders."

Captain Sullenberger will speak to Kiwanians on Thursday, June 24, about leadership and preparedness, particularly in times of change and challenge. He will empower you to reach new levels of excellence as a Kiwanis captain. The 2021 Kiwanis Education and Leadership Conference Kickoff is available for in-person and virtual attendees.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT IN-PERSON ATTENDANCE in SLC

Kiwanis International has adopted the meeting guidelines of the World Health Organization (WHO) and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). We intend to meet or exceed every rule for pre-meeting testing and preparation and will follow guidelines for suggested spacing and social distancing during meals and meetings.

- All attendees must attest that they have been fully vaccinated as defined by the CDC or have received a negative COVID-19 test result within five days of the first day that the attendee will be attending meetings.
- All attendees attending the meetings shall sign a waiver of COVID-19 claims.
- Any attendee who has tested positive for COVID-19 is prohibited from attending the meetings unless they provide proof of two negative tests after contracting COVID-19.
- Any attendee who is not fully vaccinated and has been knowingly exposed to an individual who has tested positive for COVID-19 within 14 days prior to the meetings is prohibited from attending the meetings.
- All attendees agree to undergo a temperature test prior to the beginning of any meeting. Any attendee who has a temperature higher than 100.3 degrees Fahrenheit will be excluded from attending the meetings in person, but may attend virtually.
- All attendees agree to wear face coverings while attending the meetings and in common spaces.
- All attendees agree to abide by strict social distancing protocols established by the hotel and Kiwanis.

Service Leadership Program Advisor Background Checks

Dear Kiwanians,

While the Kiwanis International requirement for background checks for those working with youth and our Service Leadership Programs (SLP) has not changed, the impact on non-compliant individuals and clubs has changed.

In an effort to seek compliance with KI's Youth Protection Guidelines, Kiwanis International has taken the step of notifying schools when an advisor's background check has expired, thereby disallowing the advisor's campus privileges. (See KI letters from earlier this year: strengthened Youth Protection policies letter and sample non-approved advisor letter.)

Additionally, if the SLP club is showing no advisors with approved background checks, Kiwanis International is removing the sponsoring club from the SLP roster.

It is of utmost importance to have background checks completed and paid, or update your records with advisors who have current background checks. Click here for a current list of those advisors who require updated background checks. Advisors need to log into the member portal (Kiwanis Connect) and initiate the background check process under "background check." Or contact the club secretary for a member-specific email link sent from the secretary dashboard. Contact Kiwanis International at backgroundchecks@kiwanis.org for a member-specific email link.



Stroke has a new indicator

They say if you email this to ten people, you stand a chance of saving one life. Blood Clots/Stroke – They Now Have a Fourth Indicator, the Tongue

STROKE: Remember the 1st Three Letters.... **S. T. R.**

During a BBQ, a woman stumbled and took a little fall - she assured everyone that she was fine (they offered to call paramedics) ...she said she had just tripped over a brick because of her new shoes.

They got her cleaned up and got her a new plate of food. While she appeared a bit shaken up, Jane went about enjoying herself the rest of the evening. Jane's husband called later telling everyone that his wife had been taken to the hospital - (at 6:00

PM Jane passed away) She had suffered a stroke at the BBQ. Had they known how to identify the signs of a stroke, perhaps Jane would be with us today. Some don't die. They end up in a helpless, hopeless condition instead.

STROKE IDENTIFICATION:

A neurologist says that if he can get to a stroke victim within 3 hours, he can totally reverse the effects of a stroke...totally. He said the trick was getting a stroke recognized, diagnosed, and then getting the patient medically cared for within 3 hours, which is tough.

RECOGNIZING A STROKE

Remember the '3' steps, STR.

Sometimes symptoms of a stroke are difficult to identify. Unfortunately, the lack of awareness spells disaster. The stroke victim may suffer severe brain damage when people nearby fail to recognize the symptoms of a stroke.

Now doctors say a bystander can recognize a stroke by asking three simple questions:

S *Ask the individual to SMILE.

T *Ask the person to TALK and SPEAK A SIMPLE SENTENCE (Coherently)

(i.e., Chicken Soup)

R*Ask him or her to RAISE BOTH ARMS.

If he or she has trouble with ANY ONE of these tasks, call emergency number <u>immediately</u> and describe the symptoms to the dispatcher.

New Sign of a Stroke -----

Stick out Your Tongue!

NOTE: Another 'sign' of a stroke is this: Ask the person to 'stick' out his tongue. If the tongue is 'crooked', if it goes to one side or the other that is also an indication of a stroke.

A cardiologist says if everyone who gets this e-mail sends it to 10 people; you can bet that at least one life will be saved.
